

Master's Level Education

As per PEEF Master Level Scholarship policy, students must have:

- i. Baluchistan domicile.
- ii. Secured at least 60% marks or a minimum CGPA 2.5 in graduation level examination held in 2023-24, 2024-25, 2025-26 (fall and spring session) in Baluchistan (Minimum sixteen years of schooling or 4-year education after HSSC / F.A / F.Sc / Grade 12 examination).
- iii. Secured admission as a full-time student in the current academic year (2025-26) in a Public Sector University of Baluchistan.
 - Students enrolled in spring/ fall session (where applicable) and morning / afternoon / evening sessions (where applicable) are also eligible to apply for PEEF Masters scholarships.
- iv. For Special Quota Scholarships, the student must fall in at least one of the Special Quota categories:
 - Orphan children
 - Children of government servants in BPS 1 – 4
 - Children belonging to minority religion
 - Special children (Disabled)
 - Children of civilians martyred in terrorist attacks
 - Children of divorced mothers
- v. Declared monthly income of parents (from all sources) is equal to or less than Rs. 60,000/-.
 - Children of Govt. employees in BPS 1-4 are exempted from condition of income, if salary is only source of income.
 - Children of civilians martyred in terrorist attacks are exempted from income limit.
- vi. Besides fulfilling PEEF eligibility criteria, the prospective student must qualify the merit and need criteria of the respective Institution.

Ineligible:

- i. *Students who have already passed / possessed MA / MSc. / MS / MPhil. / PhD etc. Degrees.*
- ii. *Beneficiary of Prime Minister Fee Reimbursement Scheme.*
- iii. *Beneficiary of any other scholarship for Master's Level studies.*

Note:

The responsibility of intimation & selection of students for PEEF scholarship rests with the Baluchistan Education Endowment Fund (BEEF) Quetta, Baluchistan.
